TO: ALL INSURANCE PRODUCERS AND PUBLIC ADJUSTERS LICENSED IN NEW JERSEY

RE: LICENSE PRINTING

The purpose of this Bulletin is to advise all insurance producers and public adjusters licensed in New Jersey that, effective August 1, 2010, the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance (“Department”) will no longer print and mail licenses to insurance producers and public adjusters. Insurance producers and public adjusters will be able to print licenses, free of charge, via State Based Systems (“SBS”) Connect.

SBS Connect is made available via the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (“NAIC”), and is currently available for your use. Information regarding free registration to this service is available on the Department’s website, www.njdoabi.org, in the “Just for Producers” area.

The change in the method of license delivery will expedite the license printing process and will grant all licensees access to a printed license within 24 hours after approval of a license application/amendment by the Department.
